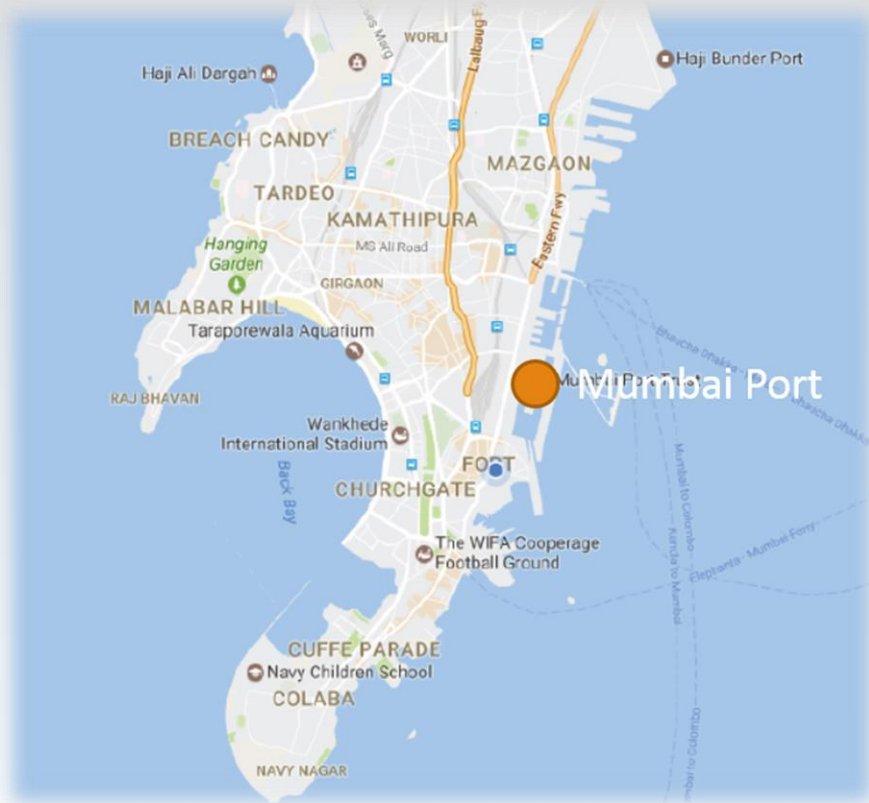

# Mumbai Port Trust



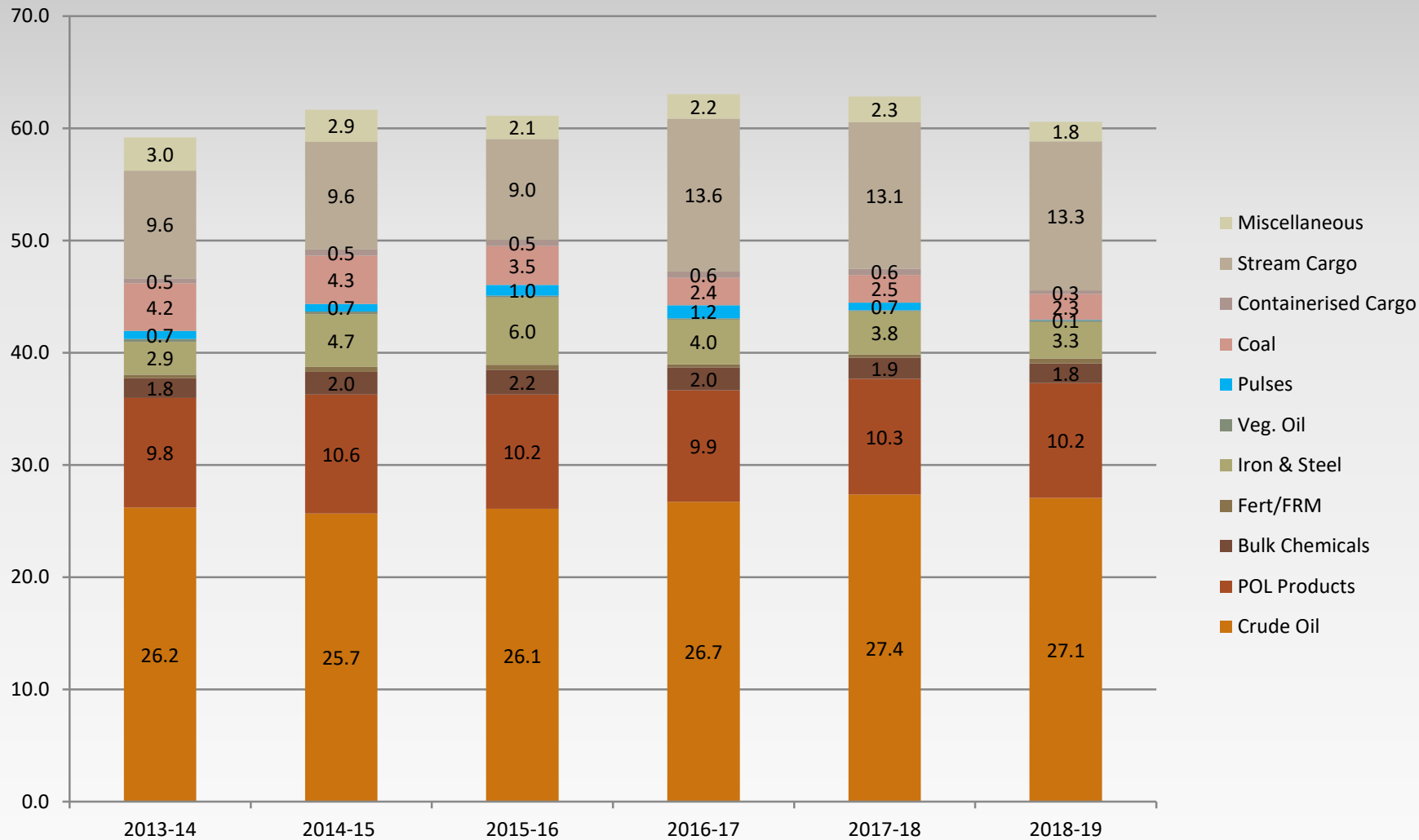
- **Premier Port**

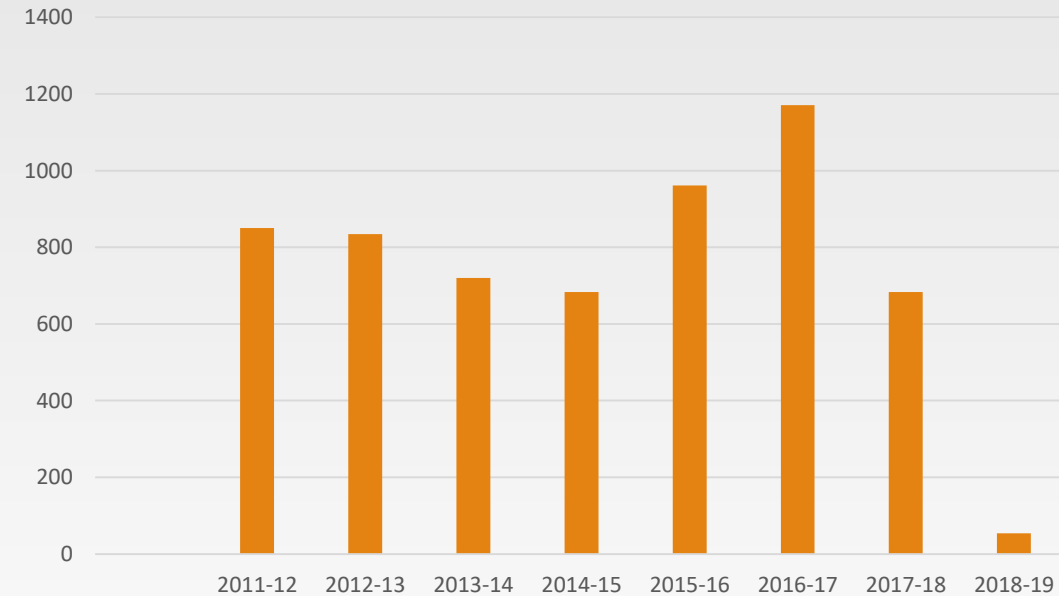

# Port Infrastructure



- 21 berths inside basin and 5 at harbor wall
- 5 Inner Anchorages and 10 Outer Anchorages
- Draft – 9.15 m at ID and 11 m at BPX
- Covered Storage (2.95 lakh sq km)
- Open Storage (4.88 lakh sq km)

# TARIFF REDUCTION & STORAGE FACILITIES FOR PULSES

---



- Storage of import pulses **inside Docks** for 60 days  
for 1<sup>st</sup> 30 days .... Rs. 77 per sq.mtr/month  
31<sup>st</sup> day to 60<sup>th</sup> day .... Rs. 155 per sq.mtr/month
- Storage of import pulses **outside Docks** upto maximum period of 180 days.

# FACILITIES

---



- Railway Network is available inside Docks within a distance of less than one km from Berth and storage areas
- Availability of Service Providers for Bagging/ Unloading pulses.
- Bagging of Bulk Pulses @ 5000 Tonnes per day
- Covered Area of 7.8 Hectares outside Indira Dock under GBL and SOR
- 3 Temporary Sheds of 6000 sq.mtr area in MOD



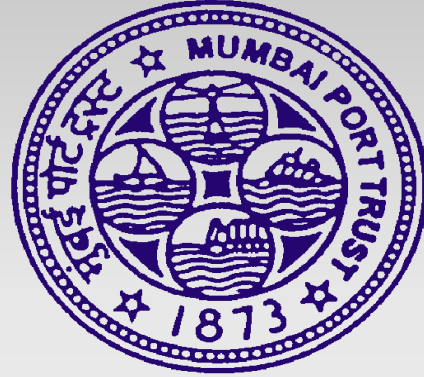


# Bulk Cargo – Agriculture Products



- **Infrastructure to Agricultural-Products and Pulses**
- **Possibility of coastal movement of this cargo to southern / eastern coast**
- **Shippers have shown their interest to call Mumbai Port for Coastal Movement**
