- Farmers Produce Trade & Commerce (Promotion & Facilitation) Ordinance, 2020.
 - Tremendous Scope for investment in Farm Gate infrastructure, in terms of village level procurement centres, assaying facilities, WDRA compliant warehouses, quality maintenance, standardization, aggregation, processing and packing etc.
 - To create a conducive environment for FPCs and Co-operative societies growth, Village to Town flow approach
 - To facilitate the procurement outside APMCs, procurement outreach increase and reduce farmer's logistics concerns including quality.
 - Generation of local employment
