Processing Criteria / Factors for consideration

- ✓ Closer to Source: catering regional demand with uninterrupted access to RM
- ✓ Margin capture:: Presumably higher margin than raw pulses
- ✓ Low price volatility providing a stable revenue stream
- √ Intervention End-to-end supply chain
- ✓ Ensures continuous delivery of high quality product even with variability of input quality
- ✓ Multiple SKUs

- ✓ Diversify intermediary risks
- **✓** Access to larger customer base
- ✓ Need to Bring global scale to evolving Indian pulse industry
- ✓ Establish a consumer brand
- Automation Superior design, lesser space and lower power consumption
- √ Facilitate Downstream opportunities Food Processing value added product offerings



New AgriCulture Reforms – Ordinances intended delivery

Three Ordinances announced: Stated Objective: To create Free, transparent and efficient Agri Eco-System

The Essential Commodities (Amendment) ordinance 2020 (Abolishing ECA)

- Abolishing ECA Remove restrictions
 on stocking of Food produce caveates
- Better Price realization for farmers encouraging bulk Positions
- Stability of market prices to consumers
- Imposition in Extra ordinary condition:
 - 100% retail price rise –
 Horticulture
 - 50% retail price rise –
 nonperishable Food stuff

Not applicable to Processor or value chain Participant.

Farmers' Produce trade and commerce Production & Facilitation (APMC Alternatives)


- More choice of markets for farmers to sell their produce

Pulses Processing Ecosystem Reform Ordinance Imperatives

Imperatives across Ordinances:

- Power of central govt to give direction to state Vs to enforce the actions / compliance
- All authorities for registration: Public servant authorities: Monitoring and supervision Guidelines to expedite
 the projects
- For Several agreements emerging as part of implementation better to clarify on Must have clauses Protecting interest of all stakeholders specimen agreements can be made available for reference

ECA – Ordinance

- Eliminate subjectivity in determining Value chain Participant- will wholesaler qualify-Revenue turnover criteria
- Level of stocking for non processors?
- State level enforcement authorities need to be well aligned on scope and instances of enforcement
- Facilitate Corporate Miniatures of FCI / NAFED ?
- Refraining from Knee jerk Price capping:
 MSP Vs Retail Price balancing
- Specify process for stock reporting/ Liquidation in case ECA is imposed

APMC Alternatives Ordinance

- Common E trading fair trade: minimum Guidelines
- Interoperability amongst platforms –
 Technology interventions
- Central Govt level reporting of trades needs clarity Is there common portal where trades will be captured?
- Ambiguities leading to flexibility in interpretations
- How to ensure powers of Agriculture
 Marketing advisors properly channelized
