‘We don’t want tur prices to top ₹125/kg’

The government is keeping a close watch on run-away tur prices and willing to rein it in with stern action if prices do not settle at current level.

Rohit Kumar Singh, Secretary, Department of Consumer Affairs said the government expects tur prices to settle at the current level (₹111 a kg) and is tracking it on a daily basis. “If it goes any further we will start taking action and definitely do not want it to touch ₹125-130,” he said.

PREDICTIVE ANALYSIS

Speculation on social media, in contrast to reality, are driving the pulses and other agricultural commodities prices, he said.

In order to tackle speculative trade, he said the government is collecting details of production and prices of over 22 commodities from 500 centres across the country and

updating it daily on the government portal to scotch rumours. The government has also started predictive pricing by a month in advance and is checking its accuracy through the root mean square formula, he said at the sixth edition of The Pulses Conclave on Friday.

Besides keeping an eye on pulses production in India, the government is also looking at development in other countries that are exporting to India. For instance, he said Myanmar has assured to export 7.5 lakh tonnes of urad while Canada and East Africa have ample stock of masoor (lentil) for sales to India.

Recently, Singh said pulses consignment from Mozambique to India was stuck after the US imposed trade restrictions by the Financial Action Task Force for terror funding but the issue was sorted by India in two days. The government is also working with Ethiopia to grow tur for consumption in India.

देशात पुरेशी तूरडाळ

‘यंदा देशात तूरडाळीचे ३६.६६ लाख टन इतके उत्पादन झाले आहे. मागणीपेक्षा हे उत्पादन काहीसे कमी असले, तरी आयात करण्यासंबंधी तयारी पूर्ण झाली आहे. त्यामुळे देशात पुरेशा प्रमाणात तूरडाळ आहे,’ अशी माहिती केंद्रीय ग्राहकसंबंधी व्यवहार मंत्रालयाचे सचिव रोहित कुमार सिंह यांनी शुक्रवारी मुंबईत दिली. ‘इंडियन पल्सेस अँड ग्रेन्स असोसिएशन’ने (आयपीजीए) मुंबईत आंतरराष्ट्रीय डाळ परिषद आयोजित केली आहे. यावेळी रोहित कुमार सिंह उपस्थित होते. त्यांनी निवडक पत्रकारांशी संवाद साधला.

‘देशातील डाळ व विशेषतः तूरडाळीचे उत्पादन, उपलब्धता व मागणी, याबाबत समाज माध्यमांवर काही अफवा पसरविल्या जात आहेत. परंतु कृषी मंत्रालयाकडे अधिकृत माहिती उपलब्ध आहे. त्यानुसार देशातील डाळ उत्पादनात दरवर्षी वाढ होत आहे. यंदाचे उत्पादनही समाधानकारक आहे. दरवाढ होऊ नये, यासाठी केंद्रीय ग्राहक व्यवहार मंत्रालयाने आयातीचे गणित बांधले आहे. विशेषतः तूरडाळीची तूट भासणार नाही व त्यामुळे दरवाढदेखील होणार नाही, हे नक्की,’ असे ते म्हणाले.

कृत्रिम दरवाढ झाल्यास कारवाईचा इशारा

तूरडाळीचे उत्पादन किंचित कमी आल्याने म्यानमारहून चांगली तूरडाळ आयात केली जात आहे. या पाश्र्वभूमीवर काही मोठ्या आयातदारांनी साठवणूक करून त्यानंतर कृत्रिम दरवाढीचे प्रयत्न सुरू केले आहेत. तूरडाळीची अशा प्रकारे कृत्रिम दरवाढ झाल्यास कडक कारवाईचा इशारा रोहित कुमार सिंह यांनी यावेळी दिला.

देशात काही ठिकाणी तूरडाळीऐवजी मसूरडाळीची मागणी वाढलेली आहे. याबाबत त्यांनी भाष्य केले. ‘देशात तीन-चार वर्षांत खाद्यान्नांच्या सवयीत बदल झाले आहेत. प्रथिनयुक्त आहार घ्यायला हवा, याबाबत जागरुकता निर्माण झाली आहे. ही जागरुकता केवळ शाकाहारीच नाही, तर मांसाहार करणाऱ्यांमध्येही निर्माण झाल्याने मांसाहार त्यागून शाकाहारी होणाऱ्यांचा आकडा वाढत आहे. प्रथिनयुक्त पदार्थांसाठी शाकाहार अवलंबविणारे सर्वप्रथम तूरडाळ, त्यानंतर मसूरडाळ व काबुली चण्याचे सेवन करतात.

यामुळेच तूरडाळ व मसूरडाळीची मागणी वाढली आहे. दक्षिणतदेखील शाकाहार वाढला असल्याने तूरडाळ व उडदाच्या डाळीचे सेवन वाढले आहे. देशातील एकूण डाळ मागणीत ४६ टक्के हरभरा, ११ टक्के तूर, १० टक्के उडीद, आठ टक्के मसूर व त्यानंतर उर्वरित डाळींचा समावेश असतो,’ असेही त्यांनी सांगितले. आयपीजीएचे अध्यक्ष बिमल कोठारी, म्यानमारचे राजदूत मो क्वाव ऑंग, कॅनडाचे उच्चायुक्त कॅमेरून मॅके, कॅनडाच्या सांस्कृतिकेचेवर्न प्रांताचे कृषिमंत्री डेविड मेरिट यावेळी उपस्थित होते.

तूर, उडदाचे होणार संयुक्त संशोधन

प्रथिनयुक्त तूर आणि उडिद यांच्यामार्फत खाद्यान्न सुरक्षा तयार करण्यासाठी येत्या काळात भरीव गुंतवणुकीसह त्यामध्ये संशोधन होणार आहे. याद्वारे या दोन्ही पिकांची उत्पादकता वाढवण्यासाठी भारत-ब्राझिल यांच्यात शनिवारी करार झाला. 'इंडियन फ्लेक्स अँड ग्रेन्स असोसिएशन'च्या (आयपीजीए) आंतरराष्ट्रीय डाळ परिषदेत मुंबईत हा करार करण्यात आला आहे.

भारत हा जगातील सर्वाधिक डाळ, विशेषतः तूरडाळ सेवन करणारा देश आहे. मात्र, उत्पादन तुलनेने कमी असल्याने भारताला दरवर्षी डाळी आयात कराव्या लागतात. त्याचप्रमाणे कॅनडा, ऑस्ट्रेलिया, म्यानमार, ब्राझिल, मोझाम्बिक हे देश डाळ उत्पादनात झपाट्याने पुढे जात आहेत. हे ध्यानात घेऊनच त्या देशांमधील तूर

भारत-ब्राझिल यांच्यात उत्पादकता वाढीसाठी करार



उत्पादन तंत्रज्ञानाचा भारतात अवलंब करण्यासाठी 'आयपीजीए'ने पुढाकार घेतला आहे. यासाठी आयोजित परिषदेत ब्राझिलशी महत्त्वाचा करार करण्यात आला.

उभय देशांनी खाद्यान्न सुरक्षेसाठी एकत्र येण्याचा निर्णय घेतला आहे. यासाठीच हा सामंजस्य करार करण्यात आला आहे. त्यानुसार दोन्ही देश डाळीसंदर्भातील बाजाराची मागणी, दर्जा यांच्या अभ्यासाद्वारे डाळ व्यापाराला प्रोत्साहन देण्यासह या (पान १२वर)

तूर, उडदाचे होणार संयुक्त संशोधन

(पान एकवरून)

संदर्भातील तंत्रज्ञान सहकार्य करण्यावर भर दिला जाणार आहे. आयपीजीए व ब्राझिलच्या कृषी उत्पादन संघटनेदरम्यान हा करार झाला. या दोन्ही संघटना तूर व उडदाची उत्पादकता वाढविण्यासाठी कापणीपूर्व व कापणीनंतर विशेष संशोधन करतील, असे करारात ठरविण्यात आले.

तुरीत संशोधन अभाव

'भारतात तुरीसंदर्भात संशोधनाचा अभाव आहे व त्यामुळे पीक उत्पादकता वाढीचा वेग कमी आहे', अशी खंत माजी केंद्रीय कृषी सचिव सिराज हुसैन यांनी या परिषदेत व्यक्त केली. 'तूर वगळता त्या श्रेणीतील अन्य सर्व पिकांत चांगले संशोधन झाले

आहे. हरभरा हे त्याचे उत्तम उदाहरण आहे. आतापर्यंत उत्तर भारतात घेतले जाणारे उत्पादन हे मध्य भारतातदेखील घेतले जात आहे. याद्वारे उत्पादन वाढले आहे. याचप्रमाणे साखरेचे उत्पादनदेखील संशोधनामुळे वाढले असून, आता आपण साखर निर्यात करीत आहोत. परंतु तुरीचे पीक हे वातावरणाबाबत संवेदनशील असते. वातावरणात थोडा जरी बदल झाला तरी पीक खराब होते. तसे होऊ नये यासाठी वातावरणानुकूल, कुठल्याही वातावरणात तग धरणारे बियाणे तयार करावे लागेल व त्यासाठी संशोधनाची गरज आहे. तुरीबाबत हे संशोधन झालेलेच नाही', असे हुसैन यांनी या परिषदेवेळी 'महाराष्ट्र टाइम्स'ला सांगितले.

भारत २०३०पर्यंत डाळीत स्वयंपूर्ण

भारत हा जगातील सर्वाधिक डाळी खाणारा देश असल्याने अनेकदा डाळीची आयात करावी लागते. मात्र आता डाळ उत्पादन क्षेत्राचा नव्याने विचार सुरू झाला आहे. त्यामुळे २०२९-३०पर्यंत भारत हा डाळ क्षेत्रात स्वयंपूर्ण होईल, असा विश्वास केंद्रीय कृषी आयुक्त पी. के. सिंह यांनी व्यक्त केला. आंतरराष्ट्रीय परिषदेसाठी आले असता 'महाराष्ट्र टाइम्स'ने त्यांच्याशी चर्चा केली.



■ भारतात तुरडाळ हा विषय कायम संवेदनशील राहिला आहे. उत्पादन कमी-अधिक होत असताना मागणी सातत्याने वाढती असते. यात समतोल कसा साधता येईल?

भारतातील तूर लागवड क्षेत्र हे पावसावर अवलंबून असलेल्या भागात आहे. त्यामुळे वातावरणातील बदलाचा तत्काळ परिणाम तूर लागवडीवर होत असतो. पाऊस खूप झाला तरी किंवा गरजेपेक्षा कमी झाला तरी, पीक खराब होते. जसे यावर्षी कर्नाटकमध्ये अतिवृष्टीमुळे पीक वाया गेले. यंदा तेथे कमी लागवड झाली. हे मागील चार-पाच वर्षांत सातत्याने दिसले आहे. यासाठीच वातावरणाशी अनुकूल किंवा वातावरणाला लवचिक असे तुरीचे वाण विकसित करण्याबाबत अभ्यास सुरू झाला आहे.

■ वातावरणाशी अनुकूल असे किती वाण तयार झाले आहेत?

असे काही वाण आले आहेत. पण जुन्या तूर प्रकारानुसार आपण संपूर्ण देशात एकाचवेळी अशा नवीन वाण असलेल्या तुरीची लागवड करू शकत नाही. त्यासाठी क्षेत्रनिहाय कृषी पर्यावरणीय अभ्यास अत्यावश्यक असेल. हा अभ्यासदेखील सुरू झाला आहे. मुख्य म्हणजे, असा अभ्यास केवळ तुरीच्याबाबतीच नाही, तर महत्वाच्या सर्वच डाळीबाबत केला जात आहे. याच अभ्यासामुळे आतापर्यंत केवळ उत्तर भारतात पिकवले जाणारे हरभऱ्याचे पीक आता मध्य भारतातदेखील घेतले जात आहे. यातून हरभऱ्याचे उत्पादन खूप वाढले आहे. परंतु तुरडाळीची मागणी ही विस्तृत आहे. त्यामुळे हरभऱ्यासारखी स्थिती



तुरीमध्ये दिसण्यास वेळ लागेल. पण नवीन वाण, नवीन क्षेत्रात तयार केले जात आहेत, हे नक्की.

■ अशा वेगळ्या वाणांचे नवीन क्षेत्र कुठले?

मध्य प्रदेश, महाराष्ट्र व कर्नाटक, हे सुरुवातीपासूनच तूर लागवडीचे क्षेत्र आहेत. यातील काही भागात तुरीची उत्पादकता खूप कमी आहे. तिथे असे नवीन वाण तयार करण्यावर भर दिला जात आहे, जे पावसाच्या पाण्यावर अवलंबून असले, तरी वातावरणीय बदलानुसार तूर उत्पादित होऊ शकेल, असा प्रयत्न केला जात आहे. काही ठिकाणी तांदळाचे पीक घेतले जाते, मात्र त्याची उत्पादकता कमी आहे. त्या ठिकाणी तूर लागवडीसाठी प्रयत्न केले जात आहेत.

■ या सर्व प्रयत्नांनंतर डाळीचे भविष्य काय असेल?

पाच वर्षांपूर्वी सर्वच डाळींची उत्पादकता प्रतिहेक्टर ६५० किलो इतकी होती. ती ८८० किलोवर गेली आहे. हा आकडा १२०० किलोवर नेण्यासाठी प्रयत्न आहे. सर्व अभ्यास, संशोधन हे त्याचदृष्टीने सुरू आहे. उत्पादकता १२०० किलो प्रतिहेक्टरवर जाईल, त्यावेळी आपण डाळीबाबत स्वयंपूर्ण असू. आपण डाळीचे जगातील मोठे निर्यातदार असू. २०२९-३०पर्यंत हे लक्ष्य गाठण्याचे उद्दिष्ट केंद्रीय कृषी मंत्रालयाने समोर ठेवले आहे.

देशात डाळी व कडधान्य यांचे उत्पादन दरवर्षी पावणेतीन कोटी टनांच्या आसपास होते. तर त्यांचा खप वार्षिक तीन टनांच्या आसपास आहे. दक्षिण आफ्रिका, म्यानमार येथून उडीद व तूर डाळीची आयात करण्याची चर्चा सुरू असून तेथून

आपल्याला सुरळीत पुरवठा होईल, असा विश्वासही त्यांनी व्यक्त केला. सध्या देशातील गरिबीचे प्रमाण कमी झाले असून लोकांच्या खाद्यविषयक सवयी बदलल्या आहेत. त्यामुळे मांसाहाराकडून लोक प्रथिनांसाठी डाळींकडे वळत आहेत. लोकसंख्या वाढ आणि उत्पादन वाढही झाल्यामुळे देशात डाळींचा खप मोठ्या प्रमाणावर वाढला आहे, असेही सिंह म्हणाले.

मात्र, डाळींच्या साठ्याबाबत केंद्राने अचानक निर्णय घेतल्यास त्यांच्या दरांबाबत अस्थिरता निर्माण होईल. आम्ही आवश्यक वस्तू कायदानुसार साठा किती असावा याबाबत व्यापारांकडे विचारणा करतो. त्यानंतरही किमती स्थिर झाल्या नाहीत तर कारवाई करतो. त्यासाठी गोदामांना मैत्रीपूर्ण भेटीही दिल्या जातात असे सचिव म्हणाले.

भारत को दलहन उत्पादन में आत्मनिर्भर बनाने का वैश्विक महामंथन

देश को दाल उत्पादन में आत्मनिर्भर बनाने के लिए सरकार के साथ-साथ दलहन कारोबारी भी प्रयासरत है। भारतीय दलहन और अनाज संघ (आईपीजीए) ने द पल्स कॉन्क्लेव 2023 का आयोजन किया है।

तीन दिवसीय दलहन महाकुंभ में दाल उत्पादन करने वाले 20 देशों के प्रतिनिधि शामिल हुए हैं। भारतीय दलहन कारोबारियों की कोशिश जलवायु परिवर्तन के प्रभाव और नई तकनीक की जानकारी के बल पर देश को दाल उत्पादन में आत्मनिर्भर बनाना है।

मुंबई में शुरू हुए तीन दिवसीय द पल्स कॉन्क्लेव 2023 की जानकारी देते हुए हुए आईपीजीए के अध्यक्ष बिमल कोठारी कहते हैं कि दालों और अनाज उत्पादन पर जलवायु परिवर्तन के प्रतिकूल प्रभावों से निपटने पर हमारा ध्यान है।

भारतीय बाजार सहभागियों, भारत और विदेश में सभी सहयोगियों के बीच अच्छे संबंधों को बढ़ावा देने का प्रयास है। दुनियाभर के लोगों को पता है कि भारत में दालों के उत्पादन की असीम संभावनाएं हैं। उत्पादन बढ़ाने के लिए की जा रही रिसर्च में हम लोग मदद कर रहे हैं। हमारा पूरा ध्यान दालों में देश को पूरी तरह से आत्मनिर्भर बनाने पर है।

इस सेमिनार में दुनियाभर रिसर्च वैज्ञानिक, खाद्य टेक्नोलॉजिस्ट, प्रोसेसिंग कंपनियां व सेवा प्रदाताओं और संबंधित लोग शामिल हुए हैं। जो दलहन फसलों की वर्तमान स्थिति, भविष्य के रुझान, व्यापार नीतियों, स्थिरता और तकनीकी विकास पर चर्चा करेंगे। भारत को आत्मनिर्भर बनाने और पोषण सुरक्षा को आगे बढ़ाने में सहायता करने के लिए दाल सेक्टर का विश्व का सबसे बड़ा आयोजन है।

कोठारी कहते हैं कि भारत में सभी तरह की दालों का सन 2022-23 में करीब 275 लाख टन उत्पादन किया गया है, जो कि अब तक का रिकॉर्ड है। बिमल कोठारी कहते हैं कि देश में पिछले 10 सालों में दालों की खेती तेजी से बढ़ी है। रेकॉर्ड उत्पादन हुआ है लेकिन उसी तरह से मांग भी बढ़ी है।

हां, कुछ ऐसी दालें हैं, जिनका उत्पादन बढ़ाने की जरूरत है। देश में सभी तरह की दालों का कुल कारोबार करीब 2 लाख करोड़ रुपये के आसपास है। भारत के दाल के बाजार को 2026 तक 25 अरब अमेरिकी डॉलर तक पहुंचने की उम्मीद है और 2030 तक इसकी मांग में 330-350 लाख टन तक का इज़ाफा होगा।

दालों के मामले में देश आत्मनिर्भरता की ओर तेजी से आगे बढ़ रहा है। देश का किसान चना और मूंग दालों का उत्पादन मांग से कहीं ज्यादा कर रहा है, जबकि अरहर, मसूर और उड़द दालों की कमी बनी हुई है।

रोहित कुमार सिंग, आयएस, ग्राहक व्यवहार विभाग, भारत सरकारचे सचिव म्हणाले, "धोरण निर्माते म्हणून, योग्य व्यापार धोरणांद्वारे ग्राहक आणि उत्पादक यांच्या हितामध्ये समतोल राखणे हे आमचे प्राधान्य आहे. भारतातील डाळींचे उत्पादन काळानुसार वाढत आहे. ग्राहकांच्या हिताचे संरक्षण करण्यासाठी आणि व्यापार धोरणांच्या बाबतीत पारदर्शकता सुनिश्चित करण्यासाठी सातत्यपूर्ण धोरण असणे महत्वाचे आहे."

डेव्हिड मॅरिट, कृषी मंत्री, सास्काचेवान प्रांत, कॅनडा यांनी त्यांच्या शिष्टमंडळासह कॉन्क्लेव्हमध्ये सक्रिय सहभाग घेतला. याशिवाय, भारत ज्यांच्याशी व्यापार करतो अशा विविध देशांतील मोठ्या संख्येने कॉन्सुलर कॉर्प्स होते.
