2. With reference to the subject mentioned above, it is informed that the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Government of India has allowed the import of Lentils from Russia with the following phytosanitary requirements until the final notification made:

Free from: (a) Lepidium draba (Hoary cress) (b) Bromus sterilis (Barren broom) (c) Ditylenchus dispaci (Stem and bulb nematode)	 (i) Free from quarantine weed seeds; (ii) Free from soil contamination and other plant debris; (iii) Fumigation with 3g Phosphine (PH₃) gas/ MT of Lentils for 7 days (or)
	Fumigation with Methyl bromide at 32 g/m ³ for 24 hrs at 21 ^o C The treatment should be endorsed on
	Phytosanitary Certificate issued at the Country of origin/re-export.

- 3. NPPO of Russia is further informed to send the shipments with fumigation of 3g Phosphine (PH₃) gas/ MT of Lentils for 7 days as agreed mutually.
